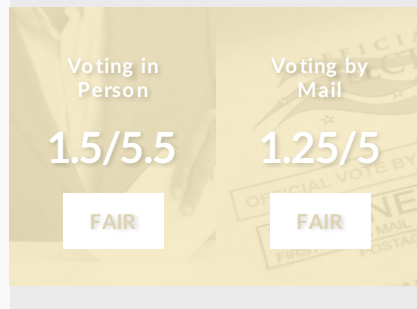
## North Carolina's Democracy Tally



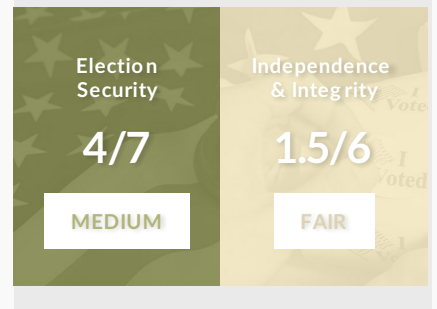
